

## Appendix 1

### International and Chapter congress series and sites

The Federation has had several series of official Congresses. These are in addition to numerous additional symposia held regionally on specific topics. The Congresses have been held in six series. For many years, two separate series of major International Congresses were held, one with EEG and one with EMG as its major area of interest.

In the early years, the EEG series was known generally as the International Congress. By 1969, the EEG Congresses were known as the International Congress of Electroencephalography and Clinical Neurophysiology. The EMG Congress series initially was known as the International Congress of EMG. By 1992, the EMG Congresses were known as the International Congress of Electromyography and Clinical Neurophysiology. The latter names are used below for simplicity of presentation.

Since 1999, the two International Congress series have been combined into a unified International Congress of Clinical Neurophysiology (ICCN). The latter now are held every 4 years. To recognize its roots in the two separate series International Congresses, the ICCN continued its count from the sum of the two previous series.

Between the quadrennial worldwide congresses, three Chapters hold their own regional Chapter congresses. The North American Chapter does not hold such congresses. The European Congress series predates formation of the European Chapter itself. Some congresses formally were named Symposia.
