Education and Research Fellowship FAQ

- How do I know if I am a member of one of IFCN's member societies?
 - To become a member of a Member Society within IFCN you must contact the society directly.
 - Creating an account on the IFCN website does not make you a member of a society. For a full list of societies : <https://www.ifcn.info/membership/member-chapter-overview>
 - If your home country does not have a society you can apply to join ICNS (International Clinical Neurophysiology Society)

 - To apply to the fellowship, you must have been a society for at least one year

Education and Research Fellowship FAQ

How do I find a training host institution?

- Ask at your training facility or place of work if they have any recommendations
- Search by way of specialty or area of interest
- IFCN has a core list of Host institutions that will help in your search; contact kzaiss@ifcn.info

How do I secure training at the facility?

It is the responsibility of the candidate to secure the training and obtain a letter of recommendation from the mentor.

How long will my training be?

- Education: 1 month with a maximum of 6 months. If you intend to train longer, please contact info@ifcn.info
- Research : 3 months to a maximum of 1 year.

What is required during my training?

- You will be required to submit a mid-term progress report at the mid point of the fellowship.
- You will be required to submit a final progress report with a letter from your mentor at the conclusion of the fellowship.

What do I need to submit?

- Certificate of membership to an IFCN Society ; ICNS included
- Passport or Government ID
- Completed application
- Letter of recommendation from your home institution
- Letter of acceptance from the Host institution supervisor/mentor
- Evidence of relevant medical training
- Full scope of intended training/research
- Letter of motivation (Research only)
- *ALL Documents must be in English*
